Have you ever thought about a career in the Building and Construction industry? We can make it happen!

The Girrawheen Trade Training Centre, in conjunction with Polytechnic West, is offering a Certificate II in Construction Pathways (Pre-Apprenticeship Bricklaying/Blocklaying). The Certificate course teaches students the practical skills and associated knowledge to work safely in the construction industry. Students undertake work experience and complete a variety of building projects in this hands-on approach to learning.

Year 11 consists of a general overview of the Building and Construction industry with a focus on bricklaying. In year 12, students may specialise in an area of interest (tiling and carpentry to be introduced in the next few years). The course costs start from \$200 per year (which is far cheaper than the same course elsewhere). All students receive a uniform, PPE, construction safety 'white card', and course qualifications are recognised nationally.

In 2014 the Cert II course will be offered on a two day format, subject to availability. Students will have the option to complete year 11 on a Tuesday & Wednesday or Thursday & Friday. This allows students adequate time to develop their skills in a new state of the art Trade Training Centre at Girrawheen Senior High School and complete site based work experience. As the course is competency based, students will be able to attain their Cert II depending on how quickly they progress. Students that progress quickly may be able to complete an additional Certificate II in another trade area, within the same timeframe.

Girrawheen Trade Training Centre have strong partnerships with Construction Training Fund, Australian Brick and Blocklaying Foundation and one of Western Australia's biggest building companies, the Alcock Brown-Neaves Group.
