Students are provided with support throughout their schooling. In three of the four on offer, students will be fast tracked into the complementary program, opening the door to endless opportunities and developing skills for a successful future.

Affiliated Programs:

STEM Club:

This after-school extra-curricular program is run on a weekly basis. It is coordinated by the 2021 Premier's Secondary Teacher of the Year, and often partners with organisations such as Sci-Tech and Shell NXplorers, where students learn to use STEM technology to devise solutions to real-world problems.

Performing Arts Academy:

Our highly successful award winning academy for Performing Arts runs classes and workshops run by industry experts and has partnerships with WAAPA, Youth Ballet WA and WA Youth Theatre. The Academy regularly achieves success competing at both state-wide and national competitions in Dance and Drama, and aims to improve confidence and team building skills among students.

Elite Sports Program:

The Elite Sports Program is the first of its type in Perth public education. The program is run in partnership with Curtin University Athletics Club where students receive coaching and learn the science behind improving technique. Built on the pillars of Fitness & Training, Growth Mindset and Personal Best, students have the opportunity to receive valuable advice from program patron, Duop Reath who is an Olympic Medal Basketballer (Boomers, Tokyo 2021) and graduate of Girrawheen Senior High School.

Leadership & Citizenship:

Recipients will be given the opportunity to run for Student Council in Year 7. If successful, they join the Student Council Form class and become part of an intensive leadership development program. The Student Council is a strong student voice leading to improvements and activities for students. This is a SCSA endorsed program in Years 10-12.

Who is eligible to receive a scholarship?


All Girrawheen Senior High School Scholarships are open to Year 6 students attending Girrawheen Senior High School for Year 7. There are a minimum of four scholarships on offer. Additional scholarships may be offered at the School's discretion.











How to Apply:

1. Application Packs are available from the reception at Girrawheen Senior High School.

2. Complete the pack, ensuring you have met the necessary requirements.

3. Return the application pack to the Girrawheen Senior High School Reception with your enrolment documents **by Week 2, Term 3**.

Application Requirements:

- One written Application form per scholarship
- Include Statement of Support from Primary School (Principal or Teacher)
- Attach copy of most recent school report
- Attach copy of NAPLAN 5 results in Reading, Writing and Numeracy

Performing Arts applicants will be required to successfully audition into the Performing Arts Academy. Auditions for Year 6 students are held in Term 4.

Elite Sports applicants are required to successfully apply for the Elite Sports Program to be considered.

Expression of Interest for Performing Arts Academy and Elite Sports Program are due by Week 2 of Term 3. Contact the school for more information.

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FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. How are scholarships selected?

- Through a grading by panel selection process:
- 1. Applications are graded against selection criteria.
- 2. Shortlisted applicants may be contacted by a panel of expert staff for more information.
- 3. Discussion and deliberation by the Panel.

2. When do applications have to be submitted?

Applications must be submitted by Week 2 of Term 3.

3. Can I submit my application after the cut-off date?

We cannot guarantee late applications will be accepted. Please contact Girrawheen Senior High School for more information.

4. What information needs to be included in the application?

Student details, Parent/Carer details, Personal Statement in response to question on Application Form, Statement of Support from Primary School Teacher or Principal, copy of most recent report and NAPLAN 5 results.

5. What is the next stage of the selection process?

Usually the application submission is all that is required, (Performing Arts Scholarship requires audition into Performing Arts Academy also) however shortlisted applicants may be contacted for more information.

6. What can I spend the \$560 scholarship money on?

\$360 can be spent to cover the cost of school fees and uniform (1 x school jumper, 2 x school polo shirts and 1 x sports shirt) in Year 7. \$200 can be spent towards additional educational expenses throughout the school year such as excursions, calculator, Dance uniform etc. If the educational item is an external purchase, the item must be approved prior to purchase by Lower School Deputy or School Principal. You will then need to purchase the item and bring in the receipt to be reimbursed to the value of \$200. It cannot be refunded for cash.

7. Does the student have to be an Australian Citizen to apply?

No, any student who is attending Girrawheen Senior High School in Year 7 will be considered for this scholarship.

8. Can Primary Schools apply on behalf of a student?

Yes, Primary Schools may submit applications on behalf of a student, however the student is still required to complete the Personal Statement in response to the question on the Application Form.

9. How will I know if my child is successful?

Successful applicants will be contacted by the school in writing. They may also be presented at Year 6 Graduation.

10. Does the STEM Scholarship recipient have to join STEM Club?

Attendance is highly encouraged to enrich the recipients area of interest.

11. Does the Performing Arts Scholarship recipient have to be part of the Performing Arts Academy?

Yes, only applicants who have successfully auditioned into Performing Arts Academy will be considered for this scholarship.

12. Does the Elite Sports Scholarship recipient have to be part of the Elite Sports Program?

Yes, only applicants who have applied and been accepted into the Elite Sports Program will be considered for this scholarship.

13. Can a student receive more than one scholarship?

No. Whilst students are encouraged to apply for multiple scholarships, if successful, they can only receive one.
